

Transport - Will there be new ways of travelling in 2040? What will that look like?


Here's how to enter:

- 2. How to enter: Your class teacher or head teacher must complete the form [not individual pupils], selecting up to 5 entries per school [any theme]. If there is more than one school in the group each school can enter up to 5 entries. One form per entry.
- 3. Maximum of 400 words per entry.
- 4. Please attach a photograph or any visual up to 1MB to support your entry.
- 5. Link to YouTube, Tik Tok or Vimeo with a short clip to support your entry [optional].
- 6. Selection criteria UKTIN's Talent Advisory Group members will select the winners. The judges' decision is final. Winners will be chosen based on creative thinking and potential usage adoption.
- 7. Deadline The latest entry date is 11.59 pm on 26 April.
- 8. Winners will be contacted w/c 13 May 2024.
- 9. Prizes First prize £300 shopping vouchers for your school, two runner-up prizes of £100 each of shopping vouchers [select from Amazon or a well-known high street retailer]. These will be electronic vouchers sent to the school.
